What is the National Agency for solar energy in Morocco?

The law 57.09 voted in January 2010 creates the National Agency for Solar Energy, a leading institution to promote and manage the solar energy sector in Morocco. The agency will be entrusted with coordinating the National Integrated Project for Solar Electricity Production.

Will Moroccan solar power be produced today?

"No electricity will be produced today," says Rachid Bayed at the Moroccan Agency for Solar Energy (Masen), which is responsible for implementing the flagship project. An occasional off day is not a concern, however.

How many workers are needed to build a solar plant in Morocco?

Once fully operational, the solar plant will only require about 50 to 100 employees (Credit: Sandrine Ceurstemont). As well as boosting Morocco's power production, the Ouarzazate project is helping the local economy. Around 2,000 workers were hired during the initial two years of construction, many of them Moroccan.

What does Morocco's Noor 1 project mean for the energy industry?

Noor 1, the first phase of the Moroccan plant, has already surpassed expectations in terms of the amount of energy it has produced. It is an encouraging result in line with Morocco's goal to reduce its fossil fuel bill by focusing on renewables while still meeting growing energy needs that are increasing by about 7% per year.

Will South Africa become a solar power supplier?

South Africa is already one of the world's top 10 producers of solar power and Rwanda is home to east Africa's first solar plant, which opened in 2014.
