Are rural areas leading the way on solar power generation?

New CPRE analysis reveals that homes in the countryside are leading the way on solar power generation. 48 of the 50 English parliamentary constituencies with the highest domestic solar generation capacity are in rural areas, while all 200 of those with the lowest are in towns and cities.

Is solar at odds with agriculture in the UK?

There is little evidence to suggest solar is at odds with agriculture in the UK. Currently, solar farms in the country have a combined capacity of around 14GW, according to research from Solar Media, of which 9.6GW is made up of ground-mounted installations.

Is rooftop solar a good idea in the UK?

Taken together, all suitable roof space and car parks in the UK could generate a whopping 117 GW, substantially more than the government's total solar target of 70 GW by 2050. With enough roof space in England to meet more than half of our solar energy targets, rooftop solar is a common sense solution that continues to be overlooked.

Are solar farms a threat to our countryside?

Solar farms continue to hit the headlines, especially in local media. We're regularly asked for help in challenging a solar proposal that would be an industrial scale intrusion into the landscape. But, climate breakdown poses the biggest threat to our countryside and we need renewable energy. How can the two be reconciled?

Will 'restricting solar panels on farmland' help food security?

A rumoured plan from the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to dramatically restrict solar panels on farmland in the UK will not help food security - which is threatened far more by climate change - let alone energy security, and is at odds with the Government's Net Zero Strategy.

How many solar installations are there in the UK?

Provisionally, as of the end of January 2019 there was 13,123 MW installed UK solar capacity across 979,983 installations. This is an increase of 323 MW in slightly more than a year. A new record peak generation from photovoltaics was set at 11.2 GW on 02 June 2024.
