Why should Timor-Leste be green?

Greening our business operations can help maximise efficiency, improve productivity, and in turn support the transition of the country to a more sustainable energy future," noted UN Timor-Leste Resident Coordinator Funmi Balogun. The project has already substantially reduced electricity costs, which were 40% of the entire Common Premises budget.

Is a solar-powered Grid a good idea in Timor-Leste?

With the new UN reforms, the United Nations in Timor-Leste, under the leadership of the Resident Coordinator has now started lighting the way with its solar-powered grid which has begun to give maximum dividends. A powerful 300 kWp photovoltaic system is producing 400,000 kWh of clean electricity annually, filling critical gaps in energy supply.

Does Timor-Leste have a blue economy?

Timor-Leste is one of several Small Island Developing States (SIDS), that is increasingly recognising the promising sustainable development opportunities represented by the blue economy. Some are also piloting new and innovative approaches to financing key blue economy interventions.

What is the Timor-Leste Blue Growth roadmap?

The Roadmap is a strategic document that explores opportunities to leverage finance at-scale for sustainable "blue growth" in Timor-Leste. Blue growth is about the sustainable use of ocean resources for economic growth and improved livelihoods, while preserving the health of ocean ecosystems.

How can we accelerate blue growth in Timor-Leste?

It is clear that a step-change in both public and private investments will be required to fully realise the blue economic opportunities in the country. The Roadmap suggests ways in which key sources of domestic and international finance can be leveraged more strategically to accelerate blue growth in Timor-Leste.

Timor-Leste has a hot tropical climate with a dry season, May-November, and a wet season, December-April. The temperature on the coast is usually between 25-35C and in the mountains at higher elevation the weather is much cooler - sometimes wet and misty and at other times clear and invigorating.

Coffee is grown by about 37% of the population in Timor-Leste, in the shade of trees in mountainous areas that are very difficult to access. We are working with ESA, the European Space Agency, using Earth observation data to monitor coffee plantations, improve quality and productivity, and increase the revenues of coffee growers to help combat poverty.

The Agroforestry Skills Project, implemented by ILO and funded by the EU Delegation in Timor-Leste, proudly supports farmers in making the most of this incredible resource. Let's grow greener and stronger, together!

DILI, Timor-Leste, Feb 08 (IPS) - Access to energy remains a concerning challenge for many in Timor-Leste. The centralised nature of the local electricity supply chain has traditionally kept consumers reliant on the national grid to overcome chronic energy shortages.

Timor-Leste has rapidly expanded electricity access to more than 83 per cent of the population but the country has yet to achieve energy security.¹ Consumer costs, even with government subsidy, remain high and outages are common. In addition, most of Timor-Leste's electricity is generated through costly and polluting diesel generators.

Timor-Leste's advantage Timor-Leste's most common native coffee variety, the Hibrido de Timor, is a hybrid of arabica and robusta that can tolerate higher temperatures. This heat tolerance allows arabica coffee plantations to expand into marginal areas with average temperatures as high as 24-25°C and in areas as low as 800m.
